The questions below are intended to assist Board members with review and discussion of the current draft of the Action Plan, stimulate other questions, and assist the Board in determining next steps on Action Plan development. The questions are formatted into the 4 major sections of the Plan.

- 2015-16 Priorities
 1. Do you agree with these priorities?
 2. Would you propose modified or additional priorities?
 3. Are the 5 priorities at the top of the second page clear and understandable?

- Priority Tasks and Activities
 1. Is the format of these tables at the right level of detail, what would you add or remove?
 2. Are the steps, deliverables, and timing appropriate?
 3. Do you think the order of the priorities and sequence of tasks within each is acceptable?
 4. What form to deliver progress reports – separate reports or updates to the structure of the “living” Action Plan?

- Financial Report and Project Funding / Workload
 1. What level of tracking does the Board desire and how often?
 2. Should additional detail in the form of a projected budget be developed now, or added later after work on Priorities has progressed?
 3. What form(s) of effort should be considered to obtain additional funding? (grants, competitive applications, private industry and/or environmental organizations, et cetera)
 4. What form to deliver financial tracking results – separate reports or updates to the structure of the “living” Action Plan?

- WRAP Planning Reference Materials (*currently placeholder materials from 2014 efforts*)
 1. What level of detail does the Board desire to have attached to “living” Action Plan?
 2. Should this section be updated periodically to track the completion of the deliverables listed in the Priorities?
 3. What other Work Plans should be linked to this section?
